Terms and Conditions

All bookings are subject to the terms and conditions set out below. When booking online, we only take payment via credit or debit card.

Our registered address is BMA House, Tavistock Square, London, WC1H 9JR, UK. The person signing or submitting the registration form must be authorised to accept all conditions as set out herein on behalf of those named above.

1. Evidence 2011

1.1 When you book a place at Evidence 2011, your registration fee includes:

- Entrance to the conference and workshops
- Lunch and refreshments
- Conference materials

2. Placing an order and our acceptance

2.1 When you register for Evidence 2011, the language that we offer to you for the conclusion of this process will be English only.

2.2 You may correct any errors on this page and then following acceptance of these terms and conditions will be asked to submit card payment details. We will then process your payment via World Pay. We will send you email confirmation of receipt of your order and a copy of these terms and conditions. Submission of your booking is an offer which will be acknowledged in writing by the BMJ Publishing Group Ltd ("BMJ Group") who administer Evidence 2011. Acceptance of the booking will take place when BMJ Group has received cleared funds for Evidence 2011. This is when our contract comes into effect. The only exception to this is where we have received a booking request from you very close to the Evidence 2011 date and we have agreed to allow you to attend, despite cleared funds having not been received. In those circumstances, the contract between us will come into effect when we confirm you are able to attend Evidence 2011.

3. Travel & hotel arrangements

3.1 We urge you not to make non-refundable travel arrangements as the BMJ Group cannot be held responsible for non-refundable travel tickets. We suggest you make your refundable travel booking after you have received confirmation from the BMJ Group.

3.2 Bookings, cancellations or amendments to hotel arrangements should be made by directly contacting the hotel/accommodation booking agency.

4. Prices and payments

4.1 The prices quoted on our website are inclusive of VAT (unless otherwise specified), which shall be payable on all bookings at the standard rate of 20% (or as amended) (VAT No 674 7384 91). Prices are valid for the relevant conference and shall be valid for such period indicated. All payments will be made in pounds sterling. For any delegates making payments from a bank account outside of the UK, your bank will convert the fee payable and the amount deducted will be subject to the exchange rate at the time.

4.2 Whilst we try to ensure that all of our prices on our website are accurate, errors may occur. If we discover an error in the prices of the products you have ordered, we will inform you as soon as possible and give you the option of recommencing your order at the correct price or cancelling it. If you do not respond to our contact we will treat the order as cancelled. If you cancel and we have already processed your payment, you will receive a full refund.

4.3 Payments must be made through the method specified above. We take all reasonable precautions to keep the details of your order and payments secure. Unless we are negligent, we cannot be held liable for losses caused as a result of unauthorised access to the information provided by you.

4.4 Please note that we may make a search with a credit reference agency, which will keep a record of that search and may share that information with other businesses. In the case of company bookings we may also make enquiries about the principal directors with a credit reference agency.

5. Cancellation, alterations, losses and refunds

5.1 Transfers from one delegate to another for the booked conference will be permitted at any time. Transfers from one conference to another will be at the BMJ Group's absolute discretion.

5.2 Cancellation charges, for contracted bookings, are follows:

- If written notice is received within 20 or more working days before date of the event, a full refund will be given.
- If written notice is received between 8-19 working days before the date of the event, your fee will be refunded in full, less £120 administration charge. This administration charge will not apply if you have cancelled your booking within 7 working days or less after our contract comes into effect (see Clause 2.2).
- If written notice is received within 7 working days or less prior to the event, refunds will only be given in exceptional circumstances, and at the discretion of the BMJ Group. This is because we will have had to confirm and in most cases had to pay for final numbers at the event and will have started performing our services. You therefore hereby agree that in such circumstances, that no refunds shall be permitted.

5.3 It may be necessary for reasons beyond the control of the BMJ Group to alter the content and timing of the conference, the identity of the speaker, and/or the date or the venue. In the unlikely event of the conference being cancelled (as opposed to postponed), by BMJ Group we will refund you the registration fee but to the fullest extent permitted by law, we will not be liable to you for any other costs or losses, whether direct or indirect. This does not affect your statutory rights. In addition to the fullest extent permitted by law we will not be liable to you for any losses (whether direct or indirect) based on reliance on any content at event and to the fullest extent permitted by law the BMJ Group disclaims all warranties regarding the event, whether express or implied (including by statute).

6. Venue rules

6.1 You will need to comply at all times with the rules and regulations imposed by the venue and may be excluded or removed from the conference for failure to adhere to such requirements. You will also need to ensure that you have your own insurances against any loss to your property or any loss or damage you may cause at the conference.

7. Waiver

7.1 If you breach these conditions and we take no immediate action, this will not be deemed a waiver of our rights and we will still be entitled to take further action at a later time.

8. Events beyond our reasonable control

8.1 Should BMJ Group be unable to perform any obligations under this Agreement due to causes or circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to any Act of God, war or threatened war, terrorism or threatened terrorism, fire, flood, drought, strike, lock out or actions of the venue, they will not be liable to you for any losses or claims arising from this.

9. Entire Agreement

9.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, these conditions constitute the entire agreement between you and BMJ Group with respect to the conference being booked.

10. Modifications

10.1 These conditions cannot be changed or terminated orally, and no changes or amendments to these conditions shall be binding until accepted by both you and BMJ Group in writing (which includes by fax and email).

11. Exclusion of Third Party Rights

11.1 There shall be no right whatsoever for any third party to enforce these conditions You and the BMJ Group hereby expressly wish to exclude the operation of the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999.
